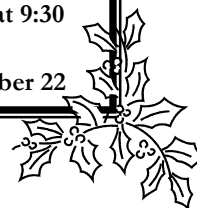

- We have started our food drive to help the Adell Food Pantry for Thanksgiving. Along with food donations we are accepting money to be used for purchasing turkeys. We have a box by the office to collect money, and each class has a basket by the Mary statue for the food items. Each class is assigned 3 food items (listed below). We will also have daily reminders to help remind the children.
 - Preschool, Kindergarten and 1st grade – canned fruit, brownie mix, pudding mix
