**Pastoral Column**

Today's first reading is a great reading to reflect upon as we think about the upcoming Parish Assessment and Renewal (PAR) Program.

Isaiah writes *“remember not the events of the past, the things of long ago consider not; see, I am doing something new!...In the desert I make a way, in the wasteland rivers.”*

I don't draw your attention to this comment because I think history is not important. However, we should expend the majority of our energy concentrating on the present and the future. If we fully rely on God, which is Isaiah's point, we will find something new, water in the desert wasteland.

Several months ago, our three parish councils unanimously voted to bring the PAR process to our cluster in the hopes that the process will help us plan for the future. Certainly, there are good things happening in our cluster. However, we need to be proactive in planning for a future with a shortage of ordained clergy and with the involvement of more lay leaders.

From April 9-25, Fr. Tom Sweetser, S.J. and Sr. Peg Bishop, will be visiting our tri-parish cluster. They will be living at the Our Lady of the Lakes rectory. During their visit, they will be meeting with several groups from our parishes. A schedule of the dates, times and locations of the meetings will be sent to the appropriate leadership groups. We know that, for some of you, it will be a big time commitment. However, we ask you to make every effort to attend the meetings if you are able. A lot of planning for our future will take place and we value and need your input.

There will also be a **TOWN HALL MEETING** on Sunday, April 18 at 1 p.m. in the Our Lady of the Lakes school gymnasium. All parishioners from all three parishes are invited and strongly encouraged to attend. Please mark your calendar and make every effort to attend this meeting. It will be a great opportunity for you to voice your opinions about what is going on in our parishes and cluster. We want to know what you want us to *keep* doing, what we should *start* doing, and what we should *stop* doing.

We are also looking for families who will be willing to help provide meals for Fr. Tom and Sr. Peg. You may do so in a variety of ways.
