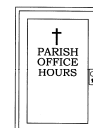

### **Pastoral Column**

In today's Gospel from Luke, we hear the beginning of Jesus' journey to Jerusalem. We hear that Jesus "resolutely determined to journey to Jerusalem." In Luke's Gospel, Jerusalem is a symbol of the place where Jesus will "be received up." That refers to Jesus' ascension back to his heavenly Father. In this Gospel reading, Jesus begins his trip to Jerusalem, a trip that will eventually lead him back to the Father. Of course, on Jesus' way back to the Father, he will have to suffer, die and rise again before the ascension can take place.

In the latter part of this Gospel reading, Jesus speaks to several prospective disciples. Each seems willing to follow Jesus, but only after taking care of some "family business." Jesus basically tells them that things of this world are not more important than helping build up the kingdom of God. We need to leave behind our own personal possessions, duties, and earthly cares if we are to truly be about building up the kingdom of God.

Those are good words for us to hear these days. No matter who we are, we are all-too-often tied up by worldly concerns. Oddly, this sometimes seems to be just as true for those of us deeply invested in faith as for those who don't practice a faith. We worry about money, buildings, tradition, family history, and the like. We worry about whether or not practicing our faith is convenient enough to fit into our schedule between working, recreating, relaxing, visiting friends, vacationing, sleeping etc. We argue about who benefits most from location of buildings and services. The earthly worries go on and on and on.

Perhaps, in today's Church, we need to hear Jesus words as much as ever. "But you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God." We need to be about building up the kingdom of God, rather than our multitude of earthly concerns.

After all, if we are to follow in Jesus' footsteps and one day be reunited with our Creator, we must first pass through the passion and death, just as Jesus did. We must suffer. We must offer ourselves up for the building up of the kingdom. We must make sacrifices. We must reach out to others with love, respect, trust and welcoming, rather than with hatred, disrespect, distrust and indifference.

Let us resolutely set ourselves toward the journey to Jerusalem. It is a journey that will bring us ever closer to God.
