Pastoral Column

As you know, our three parishes have been planning for the future. A group of representatives from all three of our parishes have been meeting for several years to talk about how we can work more closely together to make the best use of our resources, from sharing the work of co-pastors and other staff to financial resources and other services. We already do a lot of sharing on a cluster level.

One example is our religious education programs. For years, we have been working together to share services and programs like retreats, mission trips and sacramental preparation programs. We also have an agreement that families can choose the religious education program that best fits their needs from any of the three parishes. Last year, Our Lady of the Lakes began a family program which was very successful. Any families from any of our three parishes are welcome to attend the family program. At the same time, if anyone from Our Lady of the Lakes prefers a traditional program, they are welcome to attend classes at Holy Rosary or St. Mary parishes. Our collaborative efforts have been very successful.

We have also been sharing services in a wider arena, with the Port Washington and Saukville cluster and at the District 10 level. This collaboration allows us to offer many more programs in a wide variety of topics at a reasonable financial cost to our parishes.

The Archdiocese of Milwaukee has directed our cluster to continue to find more ways that we can increase our collaboration, at a cluster level and in the wider arena. We have been asked to find more ways to make better use of our co-pastors' time and our financial resources. One of the things we will begin doing in September is to have joint parish council meetings. All three councils will meet together for the first part of the meeting and share such things as prayer, the Pastor's Report, and reports from several joint committees. After the joint part of the meeting, the councils will split off into their separate councils to deal with information specific to their parishes. This will help cut down the number of meetings for our co-pastors from three parish council meetings a month to one night. It will also encourage wider collaboration.

We are working on many other ideas. We will be sure to keep you informed as our planning proceeds. Please pray for all of us on the tri-parish planning committee and for all our parishes as we continue to work more collaboratively in Christ. Deb Hamm, Pastoral Associate
