

1. Meeting called to order by Curt Blaszczyk at 6:45p.m.
 2. Secretary's Report: Minutes for May 15th meeting accepted by Amy Bares; seconded by Lisa Weiss.
 3. Principal's Report: Dr Erickson commented on the golf outing. He mentioned possibly having an all parents meeting with a professional speaker/topic to entice new families. Amy Bares suggested that we have a drop off date in August next year to see the teachers and drop off supplies instead of how we did it this year. Mrs Goetsch requested that we still have the open house to meet with parents in addition to the drop off day. Paula Mayer requested everyone to hand in the green volunteer form to school if they haven't yet. Mary Beth Davis is in charge of the McDonalds fundraiser and commented that it takes a lot of receipts in order to get anything. Lori Bichler made a motion to quit doing the program.
